THE CAMERA ENTERS THE BUILDING.

INT. ELEVATOR- EVENING

Two boys are playing.

BOY 1

You want your mum to forget about the Johnsons' fight?

BOY 2

Yes! I don't wanna hear the same shit again!

BOY 1

You just have to enter the right code and close your eyes. We have to get to the top floor. If the door opens you haven't got it right!

FADING BLACK

INT. ELEVATOR- EVENING

Dr. Howard enters the elevator.

DR. HOWARD

What are you kids doing here?

BOY 1

Nothing!

(mobile phone ringing)

DR. HOWARD

Yes! I'm on my way! Keep him under control. Block the stimuli. Lower his blood pressure!

(kids whispering)

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INT. JOEL'S HOUSE- NIGHT

Ν

Joel lays on the bed. Stan is leading the memory erasing Frocedure.

I STAN

Strange things have been happening.

Ν

DR. HOWARD

U Have you checked for hyperthymesia?

Ε

STAN

He can forget small details. He just seems to be immune to our autobiographical memory inhibitor. I don't know what to do.

(Dr. Howard takes out his

laptop)

DR. HOWARD

Let's decode his visual memory. Give me his present brain activity.

STAN

DR. HOWARD

(laughing) Watching his memory struggling is just cinematic, not illegal! Lacuna says images are not intimate.

STAN

Why do you wanna do this?

DR. HOWARD

Lacuna cannot afford another failure in the newspaper! Individuals forget. The world doesn't!

INT. ROOM-AN OLD TAPE ROLLING-NIGHT

(pouring some wine into a glass)

CLEMENTINE (FROM HIS MIND)

Listening to these tapes is like playing a song you know you are supposed to remember.

JOEL

But you don't.

CLEMENTINE (FROM HIS MIND) The wine is good.

JOEL

Clementine, why do you think Lacuna sent us these tapes? Maybe if it wouldn't...

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CLEMENTINE (FROM HIS MIND)

JOEL

Yeah! You sound like a newborn with a glass of wine in its hands. Why do you listen to this crap if you are so certain of yourself? Curiosity?! No! You want your story, but how do you get it back when you only have it on a tape? That's what you don't seem to be able to do.

CLEMENTINE (FROM HIS MIND)
You can eat this tape if you want,
I'm gonna have some more wine.

INT. ROOM- DAY

(Joel watching TV)

TV SPEAKER Remembering details of your childhood is a brain cells waste. Your operational capacity is 10 per cent slower because of this. You can change everything now. Childhood memory is not an input you have chosen. Be free! Create your own life frame.

TV SPEAKER 2

Memory is a primitive reaction to stimuli. Long term memory creates history and violence. It's far time to prevent the coming war. Postpone remembrance! There is an optimized function for storage which eliminates the disadvantages of random memory.

OXT.THE OPEN AIR-DAY

We see the picks of the buildings. Then, there's a strange noise and our attention is driven towards an unusual object flying on the sky. We go back to the tops of the buildings and enter them vertically, as it we could descend through the roof. We get in front of the closed doors of an elevator.

INT. MEDICAL ROOM-DAY

We see the closed doors of a room. We hear this conversation blankly, with no image at all. Only at the end of the gonversation we can see the faces of the people talking and the interior of the room.

DOCTOR

Why do you remember the elevator?

PATIENT (UNDERCOVER REBEL)

Because I don't remember the floor.

DOCTOR

But how can you know the floor if you're inside the elevator?

PATIENT (UNDERCOVER REBEL)

There's a screen with numbers there, don't you know?

DOCTOR

So you were inside the elevator when the riot started?

PATIENT (UNDERCOVER REBEL)

Yes, there was noise.

DOCTOR

And what did you do?

PATIENT (UNDERCOVER REBEL)

I waited for the doors to open again.

DOCTOR

And?

PATIENT (UNDERCOVER REBEL)

They didn't.

DOCTOR

Do you remember the last face you saw before getting into the elevator?

INT. JONATHAN REESE'S BEDROOM. EARLY MORNING, STILL DARK

OUTSIDE

(Smart phone alarm goes off)
Jonathan, a middle aged fit
man, shuts it off and sits on
the bedside. He reaches for a
set of headphones, puts them
on, plugs them into the smart
phone and starts a radio app.
(We can hear the radio speaker

talking in the background all throughout the scene.)

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RADIO SPEAKER ...have registered a five year record in the number of deaths at sea relating to migrants illegal attempts to reach the European coasts by boat. Closer to home, tragedy doesn't spare the American shores either, as we learn from the last of mayor's office press releases that more than 7300 new yorkers are now suffering from the mysterious condition known as Déjà vu depression. In spite of the fact that it has repeatedly been confirmed that all the victims were, at some time in the past, patients of the same memory modification company, Lacuna, both the mayoral office and the company's CEO, Dr Howard Mierzwiak, deny any link between the Lacuna's practices and the vicious condition. Our field correspondent has more information on Dr Mierzwiak's latest claims...

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Jonathan Reese walks briskly to the bathroom, still having his headphones on, shoving the phone in his trousers. He turnes on a light in the bathroom and starts sprinkling water on his face and washing his teeth.

CUT TO

Jonathan's face in the mirror, continuing to brush his teeth while the radio goes on.

RADIO SPEAKER

...as before, there is no official
recognition of the memory erasing
role in triggering the physical and
psychological severe apathy these
people appear to suffer of. What's
 RADIO SPEAKER (cont'd) more
 interesting is the fact that
 the obscure deasese seems to
 not be confied to New York's
 city limits as more and more

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cases are being reported every hour from across the country.

CUT TO

Jonathan exits the bathroom and enthering the kitchen he turnes on

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RADIO SPEAKER

the light and starts to brew the coffee. The radio continues.

Whether these new cases spreading from as far as Minnesota to Washington and Luisiana, and plaguing mainly the big urban centers, are or not a direct cause of the controversial memory inhibiting techniques, remains to be confirmed.

CUT TO

On the kitchen floor, Jonathan has spread a yoga mat and now he's doing fast push-ups on it.

(The headphones and the phone have been removed. The coffee

steams on the table)

INT. JONATAN REESE'S BEDROOM. MORNING, LIGHT OUTSIDE

Jonathan selects some office clothes from the closet and puts them on. The TV is playing in another room. (In the morning light, the room looks neat and austhere) Fully clothed and well-arranged, Johnatan walks back to the bathroom.

CUT TO

Jonathan's face in the bathroom mirror.

JONATHAN REESE
Hello, I'm Jonathan Reese, I'm here
to talk about the movie... Hi, I'm
Jonathan Reese, the filmaker...

(CONTINUED) CONTINUED: 3.

Hello

CLEMENTINE (FROM HIS MIND) We are inside your mind and I don't know where we're going.

JOET

What dream is this? Are we going to crash?

CLEMENTINE (FROM HIS MIND)

A mind is never crashing. It is just transforming itself. Memory is the floor you always imagine when you're inside the elevator. It's an exterior coordinate and just a spacial pre-supposition.

JOEL

My head.

CLEMENTINE (FROM HIS MIND)

Meet me in your future memories.

The elevator starts shaking. It's going down. The camera is on the closed doors of the elevator. We hear Joel screaming. The on button of a camera ends his scream. We are looking through the digital camera and see him on his bad undertaking the procedure. Then we see that the one holding the camera is Jonathan.

I told you. We did everything that was in our power. Take her to a psychologist.

JONATHAN

I did that and here she is.

NURSE 1

You know what to do if you want to save her. Is the only way she will forget about her child's death.

JONATHAN

Oh, no! I can't believe you're suggesting that.

С 0 NURSE 1 You wanted a solution. Lacuna is Ν the rapid one. Т JONATHAN I can't believe it! Who's paying Ι you to do this? How dare you? I will never do that to my sister. EXT. BUS STATION-DAY

We are inside Joel's mind. He and Clementine from his mind are getting into a bus.

CLEMENTINE (FROM HIS MIND) When you let go you have to forgive yourself. Morning brings new meaning for you to be able to accept your oblivion. They always remind you of who you are and you always forgive them so that they can tell you new things about yourself.

JOEL

Where are we going?

CLEMENTINE (FROM HIS MIND)

We're going home.

JOEL

I can't remember. Where do we live?

CLEMENTINE (FROM HIS MIND)

Inside oblivion.

Joel and Clementine from his mind are getting down from the bus. They are entering another one.

JOEL

Hey, we've been here before. We've taken this bus to get home.

CLEMENTINE

We always take this bus to get home. (laughing)

JOEL

No. We took this bus five minutes ago. We were so close to home. What happened?

CLEMENTINE

I don't get your joke, Joel!

JOEL

Stop the bus. It's a reality trap.

CLEMENTINE

Stop screaming. People are looking at us. Come on darling, calm down. Are you feeling good? You want me to take you to a doctor?

INT. JOHNATHAN'S ROOM-NIGHT

Johnathan is sleeping in his bed. Suddenly the phone rings. He lets it ring for a couple of times, then picks it up.

JONATHAN

Hello?

He jumps out of his bad and starts dressing quickly.

INT. JOHNATAN'S SISTER HOUSE- DAY

HUSBAND

I'm glad you came. I don't know what to do. I took the baby to my mother. She's taking care of him.

JONATHAN

Where is she?

HUSBAND

In her room. One day she just couldn't get out of bed. She said

it's time for me to know the truth. She said she thought she could live with it and that's why she started a family, but it's too much now. She says she's lived every second of this before. When she looks at our son she just knows she had raised him before and that she had been here before. She said that she doesn't have the strength to do it again. She ain't capable of repeating the same story.

JONATHAN

"Deja-vu depression" symptoms.

HUSBAND

Some say it is connected to Lacuna, but it's not her case.

JONATHAN

No, it's not.

HUSBAND

What shall I do?

JONATHAN

Look after her.

HUSBAND

But she doesn't wanna see me. I hired a woman.

JONATHAN

It's not her that doesn't wanna see you. It's her depression. I'll try and talk to her.

HUSBAND

Jonathan, wait! You know, I really love your sister. But something is curious. She never used to talk about her past. You know, highschool stuff, parents, you. Tell me more about who she was before I met her.

JONATHAN

There's nothing to tell. She had a normal life. The sort of life
(MORE)

JONATHAN (cont'd)

everybody remembers, but doesn't want to talk about.

Screaming and yelling coming from upstairs. They run towards that room. They find her sitting next to the bed. She's crying.

JONATHAN'S SISTER
I've done this before. I've been

Only in horror films.

CLEMENTINE (FROM HIS MIND) Call them gothic. I never understood how is it that we remember fear?

JOEL

Maybe we keep it in our bodies and not in our mental images.

JOEL

I can't remember.

CLEMENTINE (FROM HIS MIND) Maybe it's time to stop for a coffee.

They stop the car and the camera watches them soundlessly Mhrough the car window.

EXT.STREETS-DAY

JOHNATHAN is walking the streets again. He sees people faces, but doesn't seem to observe anything. There is the Macuna advertisment on the building. He looks at the poetry lines, from the first scene, and seems to look at them long knough to have time to read them.

He sees two people fighting about something. Then we get the panoramic view of the city. (New York, maybe)

INT. CAFETERIA- DAY

JONATHAN

Thank you for accepting my invitation, Ms. Kruczynski! I want to ask for a favor.

CLEMENTINE (THE REAL ONE) I don't usually do favors, Mr...?

JONATHAN

Reese, but call me John!

CLEMENTINE (THE REAL ONE) I'm listening...

JONATHAN

It's about your husband.

CLEMENTINE (THE REAL ONE)

Not again. I don't wanna hear about him.

JONATHAN

But you have a history together and legally you're still his wife. You both underwent a memory erasing procedure at the beginning of you relationship in 2027, when Lacuna collapsed. You got back together in 2030. Why is it that Mr.Barish wanted to undertake the procedure again?

CLEMENTINE (THE REAL ONE)
Why would I answer your question?
What is this about?

We want to make a documentary about Joel's case. It's a special one. We wanna offer the people a real image about what an erasing procedure means. It's a taboo issue in this country. JONATHAN Clementine, your husband is unconscious. He cannot make meaning out of what's happening to him. I can. You have to trust me.

EXT. STREETS-DAY

We see the crowded city and people walking on the streets.

DR. HOWARD Careful with that. You don't wanna entangle the networks.

JONATHAN

Hello, Mr. Mierzwiak! I'm...

DR. HOWARD

You're the documentarist. Sit down!

JONATHAN

Thank you for meeting me!

DR. HOWARD

I know why you're here. Curiosity! That's very humane, John and we're dealing here with things that need to overcome that. Why are you interested in this particular patient?

JONATHAN

He's an interesting case.

DR. HOWARD

We are all interesting cases. Documentarists never see the potential, only the enactment.

JONATHAN

Why is Joel's erasing procedure taking so long? Is there a precedent?

I'm sorry, John! We'll have to end our session here. It got very crowded today. People are waiting at my door. It's the "deja-vu depression". It acts like an epidemics, lately.

JONATHAN

It's an effect of the erasing procedure.

PSYCHOLOGIST

How can you be so sure?

JONATHAN

I'm not, but I will find out!

PSYCHOLOGIST

Good bye, John! Take care!

EXT.A LAKE-DAY

Joel and Clementine from his mind are on a boat on the lake. The water is very still. There is no sound of anything, except the water. Joel rises up on his feet.

CLEMENTINE (FROM HIS MIND)

Be careful. You're gonna fall.

C I just wanna see where we are heading to.

CLEMENTINE (FROM HIS MIND)

N And? Do you see something?

T JOEL

Nothing! There's nothing around.

I'm getting dizzy.

Noel sits down again.

U CLEMENTINE (FROM HIS MIND)

E This is how a mind with no memories

and no fuss looks like. Isn't it

D beautiful?

Joel is up on his feet again. Looks around.

JOEL

This stillness...

He loses his balance and falls in the water.

INT. JOEL'S HOUSE- NIGHT

Dr. Howard enters the room. Jonathan is siting in the dark. Only the screen of a laptop draws light on his preoccupied face.

DR. HOWARD

Hey, thought you were done for today! What are you doing here? Planning to turn your documentary into a horror movie? It's almost 12 o'clock. (laughing)

JONATHAN

No, Dr. Howard. A documentary is already a horror movie. Fortunately we don't have to bother ourselves with that. I'm here for a different reason.

DR. HOWARD Well, what would it be?

JONATHAN

I've been watching this poor's man history on your laptop. Seems he doesn't wanna let her go.

(we see a love scene between Joel and the Clementine from his mind on the laptop screen)

DR. HOWARD

What?! How did you access that? You weren't allowed.

JONATHAN

A mutual friend of ours gave me the password. You know, people can offer you things without even being aware of it.

DR. HOWARD

Get out of here.

JONATHAN

Not yet, doctor. You have to explain me something before or I'll take care of the press tomorrow morning. Tell me, why is it that she's got a different appearance in his mind? He's having sex with her and she's calling her Clementine. But you know doctor, I've met Clementine personally and this woman in here doesn't even resemble her. What's going on doctor? Are you planting something in their brains?

DR. HOWARD

(laughing)

We haven't got the technology for inception yet.

JONATHAN

Then what is it doctor? What is a stranger's face doing inside the mind of someone who's having his memory erased?

DR. HOWARD

I will tell you the truth, but not because you are threatening me, but (MORE)

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DR. HOWARD (cont'd) because I know you will understand. Memory traces are emotionally encoded. They are part of the brain's structure. You can not erase those, but you can change the way they manifest at a conscious level. What we do is to de-realize somebody's memories of their past. We detach them from their reality background. The subjects don't own their recollections anymore, but they still got that memory trace which is automatically re-encrypted by their system. Different faces, different chronology and narrative. Even different plots. Theu just give another face to their memories. They still live with it. It's just that they don't see it.

JONATHAN

So you're just hidding the shit and people pay you fortunes to relieve them from their pain. It's all fake. What about the deja-vu symptoms?

DR. HOWARD

The emotion is reactivated when encrypted again in the erasing process. They get this paralizing sense that they have lived their lives before when they are back into society and events. It's a constant deja-vu.

JONATHAN

All these years I have been tormented by what I did to my sister. I tried to convince myself that relieving her from pain was the right thing to do. I signed a contract with Lacuna. I kept watching her grow into a lie I have designed. Now I know I did her no good. You just fool people, Mr. Howard and you were supposed to cure them.

DR. HOWARD

You can't cure anyone from himself.

JONATHAN

Then end this. I will stop Joel's erasing procedure. I will end this lie.

DR. HOWARD

No you won't do anything cause if you wake him now he won't be able to know anything. If you don't let the re-encryption of memories happen you'll have a person with no past and no sense of self. That should be a problem.

EXT. JOEL'S HOUSE-NIGHT

Johnathan and the other insurgents are outside Joel's house. They are planning to attack Lacuna by disconnecting Joel.

REBEL

There's the backdoor. You go first.

REBEL 2

We know the doctor's in there. Be careful. We don't wanna kill him.

REBEL

What if he resists.

JONATHAN

You shoot him in the leg, but we don't kill anybody. I thought that was clear.

REBEL

Hide your faces, boys!

JONATHAN

Go!

We hear the sound of the broken door.

EXT. BALCONY-NIGHT

Inside Joel's mind. He's sitting next to Clemntine. They hear a loud sound coming from nowhere.

JOEL

What was that?

CLEMENTINE (FROM HIS MIND)

A shooting maybe.

JOEL

Is there a war I don't remember?

CLEMENTINE (FROM HIS MIND) Yes! Many wars. History is not what we think about when we're having a shower. We never think about the blood and the suffering. That's why they don't need to erase our historical memory.

JOEI

Will you tell me again everything that I don't remember?

CLEMENTINE (FROM HIS MIND) In that case I will have to tell you everything that you don't know.

JOEL

I wanna know everything!

CLEMENTINE (FROM HIS MIND) Come, you will have to jump with me!

JOEL

But we'll dye!

CLEMENTINE (FROM HIS MIND)
You can't kill yourself in a dream,
can you? The only thing that you
kill it's your own fear!

JOEL

You said you will tell me everything.

CLEMENTINE (FROM HIS MIND)

First you need to forget you're alive somewhere out there.

They both jump.

INT. JOEL'S HOUSE- NIGHT

The rebels have entered Joel's house. They have captured dr. Howard. They wanna disconnect Joel from the machines.

DR. HOWARD

Wait! Wait! You don't wanna do that!

REBEL 2

Be quiet, doctor! We won't hurt anybody. We are just sending a message.

DR. HOWARD

I told you what would happen if you disconnect him.

JONATHAN

I know, doctor! A man with no past and no sense of self is not a danger for society. The real danger is Lacuna.

DR. HOWARD

You don't understand. A person with no sense of self is incapable of experiencing emotions. You will turn him into a psychopath. You have no right to do that.

JONATHAN

At least he won't have to live inside a lie you have created for him.

DR. HOWARD

One day you will regret this, John. You haven't understood anything. You were supposed to do a documentary about what we do and you did't even have the patience to get to the truth.

JONATHAN

I'm very used to regrets, dr. Howard. It won't be a problem.

DR. HOWARD

You didn't have real regrets if you weren't able to do anything to get rid of them. People want this because they need this. I listened to each of their stories. They can't see beyond their small world pain. This is the true limit. And we're helping them change it.

JONATHAN

But the pain is still there. You just give it another face. What difference does it make?

DR. HOWARD

People are not their own stories.

JONATHAN

But they are what they feel.

DR. HOWARD

Every particular feeling can have another explanation and another story. This is the possibility we offer.

JONATHAN

But you don't call it this way in public. You refer to it as self-preservation amnesia.

DR. HOWARD Yes, because it preserves the self and eliminates the story.

JONATHAN

There is no self without a story.

REBEL

We haven't got much time for soap operas, John. What shall we do?

DR. HOWARD

Will you be brave enough to give birth to a psychopath? By tomorrow he'll be a criminal in the eyes of society. He'll probably spend his life in jail. Let him live! Let him get back his story.

INT. ROOM-AN OLD TAPE ROLLING-NIGHT

CLEMENTINE (FROM HIS MIND)

I'm afraid of dying. I'll dye if you get back to reality now.

I'll stay here with you. I'm not leaving.

CLEMENTINE (FROM HIS MIND)

It's not up to you.

JOEL

But I love you.

CLEMENTINE (FROM HIS MIND)
I'm just an effect of your brain, a projection of your mind. Are you listening to me? I'm not real!

JOEL

I thought you like horror movies, not Matrix.

CLEMENTINE (FROM HIS MIND) It's not a joke, Joel. I'm not real. You wanted to know everything. There's not much to know except this.

JOEL

And how could I believe you?

INT. JOEL'S HOUSE- NIGHT

The rebels have crowded the house. Their guns are facing the floor. Everybody's waiting. Suddenly we hear the voices of the projected Clementine and Joel coming from the laptop. Everybody raises their guns, not knowing where the threat is coming from.

CLEMENTINE (FROM HIS MIND) It's not a joke, Joel. I'm not real. You wanted to know everything. There's not much to know except this.

JOEL

And how could I believe you?

JONATHAN

What's this doctor?

DR. HOWARD

You forgot to turn off the laptop after you invaded his mind. I programed the sound to turn on after 2h if the images are still running in the background. But then, what do you know about technology, dear boy?

Jonathan crushes the laptop. He's ready to disconnect Joel, but Dr. Howard takes an injection from his pocket and rushes into Joel's neck. He kills Joel, but also gets shot by the rebels in an instant.

JONATHAN

Fuck! You scared me! I don't want anything. No fake life, no fake coffee.

ROBOT

Thank you, sir! Have a good day in Paradise Park.

INT. JONATHAN'S HOUSE. NIGHT

Jonathan receives a tape. He sits down, pours some wine and starts listening to the tape. He finds out about his life before the erasure. He was somebody else, too.

Close up- the rolling tape.
