

Application for a travel grant for the 23rd Utopian Studies Society / Europe Conference *Utopian Imaginaries* Babes-Bolyai University, Cluj-Napoca, Romania July 4-7, 2023

The Utopian Studies Society (Europe) has some very limited funds available to assist with the expenses of attending the Society's annual conference and presenting work. In accordance with a decision taken at the Society's Annual General Meeting in 2003, the Committee has allocated a sum of money to be disbursed to appropriate applicants, with the following conditions.

- 1. The maximum grant available to any one individual will be **80 EUR** (your Conference Participation Fee will also be waived).
- 2. The grant money will be paid **retrospectively**, after the Paper has actually been presented at the Conference. [Normally, we arrange to pay the grant in cash during the conference].
- 3. In the event of the available funds being over-subscribed, preference will be given to Postgraduates and those from groups under-represented in the Utopian Studies community (see below). In addition, members of the USS board and the organizing committee will make assessments of the quality of the submitted abstracts.
- 4. Grants will be awarded only once to any individual; **previously successful applicants may not re-apply.**
- 5. The decision of the Chair and Treasurer of the Committee will be final.

We particularly welcome applications from participants under-represented in the Utopian Studies community, and/or who experience oppression in their lives and/or academic work. This includes, but is not limited to: people of colour; Indigenous people; women, transgender, intersex, agender, non-binary, two-spirit and others whose (lack of) gender identity does not conform to gendered norms; people with disabilities; and people from working class or poor backgrounds. *If this applies to you, please state how in a short statement at the bottom of the form (no more than a paragraph, and a sentence or two may well suffice).*
